## CHAD'S CORNER

### Journeying Through Holy Week: Reflecting on the Road to Resurrection

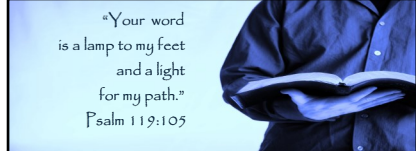
