As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fishers of men." At once they left their nets and followed him. Matthew 4:18-20

1. The first disciples were to be Jesus.

Jesus went up on a mountainside and called to him those he wanted, and they came to him. He appointed twelve that they might be with him and that he might send them out to preach... Mark 3:13-14

2. The first disciples displayed

to Jesus.

At once they left their nets and followed him. Matthew 4:20 / Mark 1:18

So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him. Luke 5:11

Disciples today are still called to...

1. Cultivate with Jesus.

I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. John 15:5

Come near to God and he will come near to you. James 4:8

2. Practice ______ to Jesus.

Why do you call me "Lord, Lord," and not do what I tell you? Luke 6:46

Not everyone who says to me, "Lord, Lord," will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. Matthew 7:21
