But it can be simple and so rewarding. God's Word strengthens us, keeps us encouraged, and reminds us of who God is and who we are in him. When Scripture is tucked into our hearts and minds, it often returns at just the right moment, guiding us when we need comfort, peace, or direction. It's not about perfection.
