CHAD'S CORNER

When You Need Revival

What comes to mind when you hear the word *revival*? For some, it's a week-long gospel meeting. For others, it's a packed church building, stirring sermons, or heartfelt singing. While those things can certainly be part of a revival, Psalm 85 reminds us that true revival begins somewhere much closer to home—it begins in the heart.

One of my favorite verses in this Psalm is a simple prayer: *"Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?"* (Psalm 85:6)

I wonder... have you ever found yourself needing revival? Not because you've stopped believing, but because you've grown weary. Maybe your passion for God isn't what it once was. Perhaps you've become distracted by the busyness of life, burdened by worry, discouraged by disappointment, or simply spiritually dry.

The good news is that our God is in the business of restoring hearts.

This morning, we'll discover from Psalm 85 that revival doesn't begin with a crowd, it begins with a person who is willing to remember God's faithfulness, return to Him in repentance, receive His Word, and respond in obedience.

If you've ever prayed, "Lord, I need a fresh start," then this psalm is for you.

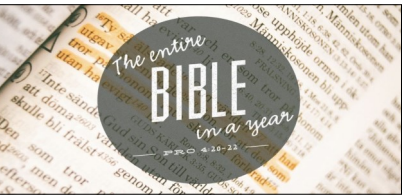

“When You Need Revival”

Psalms 85

Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?
Psalms 85:6

1. R God's faithfulness.

You, Lord, showed favor to your land; you restored the fortunes of Jacob. You forgave the iniquity of your people and covered all their sins. Psalms 85:1-2

Yet this I call to mind and therefore I have hope: Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. Lamentations 3:21-23

2. R to God in repentance.

Restore us again, God our Savior...Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you? Show us your unfailing love, Lord, and grant us your salvation. Psalms 85:4-7

Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Psalms 51:10

3. R God's Word.

I will listen to what God the Lord says... Psalms 85:8

Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ. Romans 10:17

4. R with obedience.

Love and faithfulness meet together; righteousness and peace kiss each other. Faithfulness springs forth from the earth, and righteousness looks down from heaven. The Lord will indeed give what is good, and our land will yield its harvest. Righteousness goes before him and prepares the way for his steps.
